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Does Your Child have Attention and/or Reading Problems?



The UNC Center for Development and Learning (CDL) is recruiting students (10-16 years old) who have one or two types of developmental problems affecting their learning:

- Attention/hyperactivity/distractibility problems (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder – ADHD)
- And/or reading problems (Dyslexia)

These are common problems which cause students to struggle with learning in school.

For this trial, doctors are studying an approved medication, in an investigational use, for children who have the symptoms of attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder with dyslexia or dyslexia alone.

Your child may qualify for study-related evaluations and study medication at no cost.
